THOUGHT FOR THE DAY

Note about Micah 6:6-8. “How are we to worship?” Burnt offerings, calves, thousands of rams. Not the whole answer. They can be only forms. Even child sacrifice is not the answer. Instead God asks for three things: (1) “do justly,” which means literally to act with justice toward other people. The term is ethical and relational; (2) “love mercy,” or to love being merciful; and (3) “walk humbly with your God,” which means to have an attitude of humble wisdom in response to God. While the first two principles have to do with the horizontal human-to-human relationship, this final one deals with the vertical human-to-God relationship. These three principles are the heart of worship. Page 1188, NKJ.
